Process may change at short notice due to local factors

Tool Box Meeting

- 08:00 All staff and contracted doctors rostered.
- Review daily plan
- Changes that have had to be made.
- Contingencies available.

Daily Plan

- Doctors on duty fill appointments as usual.
- Each doctor to advise the number of Telehealth appointments they are prepared to have allocated per slot.
- If extra Telehealth appointments are needed to manage patients, these will be opened up under the alias 'Dr Telehealth'. These appointments assist the reception staff with appointment provision and the patient is advised that one of the doctors will call them at some time that day.



These 'Dr Telehealth' appointments will be actioned by all doctors on duty where they
can - Clinical Services Manager will ensure that these have been allocated to someone to be
completed before the end of the day.
